ISSUE & BACKGROUND

The WICCO board has been identified by the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners (BCC) as the workforce investment act fund administrator in Clackamas County. WICCO is a 501 (c) 3 organization governed by a board of directors responsible for developing policy and overseeing local workforce development initiatives in partnership with the BCC. In compliance with the Memorandum of Agreement (see attached) between WICCO and Clackamas County, WICCO is to provide organizational update to the BCC. This study session is meant to serve that purpose.


