GOALS

The Clackamas County District Attorney’s Office is dedicated to:

- The pursuit of justice through the vigorous and impartial prosecution of those who commit crimes within Clackamas County.
- Providing the highest quality services to victims, witnesses, law enforcement and the general public.
- Promoting and advocating for programs that reduce crime.

CASES

- Reviewed 7,482 cases for adult prosecution
- Issued 1,689 felony cases
 - 1,146 felony property cases
 - 562 drug cases
- Issued 4,784 misdemeanor cases
- Issued 303 domestic violence cases
- Issued 447 juvenile delinquency cases
- Reviewed 274 cases where abused, neglected and abandoned children needed protection
- 2,284 hours of community service completed by Defendants on Community Court supervision from October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2007
- More than \$2,000,000 in restitution and compensation ordered to victims

ACHIEVEMENTS

- Initiated development of innovative Case Management Program for court:
 - 47% of all criminal cases were settled with a guilty plea within five weeks after first court appearance
 - Only 16% of all criminal cases set for trial
 - Dramatically reduced court appearances for victims, witnesses and law enforcement
 - Saved taxpayer money through reduced law enforcement overtime
- Collected more than \$19,700,000 for children during the 2008 federal fiscal year: (October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2008)
- Partnered with the Interagency Task Force (ITF) to reduce the distribution and manufacture of methamphetamine and shut down drug houses
- Provided \$37,321 in restitution to businesses for bad checks through the check enforcement program (in 2008)
- Successfully completed conversion to a new case management system
- Implemented Victims Best Practices which include victim notification and restitution procedures for every case
- Provided consultation on 100% of dependency petitions filed and declined
