## Class Prerequisites

- ✓ Dog knows sit and down
- ✓ Dog can sit-stay for 30 seconds
- ✓ Dog can tolerate slow pet from head to tail without reacting
- ✓ Dog must be able to loose leash walk
- ✓ Dog must have basic recall (on lead)
- ✓ Dog must be non-reactive
- ✓ Owner/Handler must be able to stand and move around for up to 30 minutes
- ✓ Owner/Handler must be able to walk briskly
