- Regarding elementary and other schools; check if it's appropriate for destination
- Include schools that have community education classes, e.g. Clackamas Community College
- Kellogg Creek Trail; does it exist?
- Boat ramps; omit
- River Villa Park; sign at Courtney
- River Road; need sign for River Villa Park?
- McLoughlin Blvd; sign for Springwater Corridor
- High Rocks; add as destination

Show ODOT sign standard.

River Forest Drive; nice bike route.

Index Map - Map 1; show Trolley Trail.

Naef doesn't go through; change Bike It! Map.

We watched the Historic Columbia River Highway Video Dick Weber brought for us. Very good video.

Scott distributed examples of sign mock-ups and the neighborhood maps showing the locations of the destinations.
