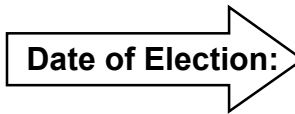

Ballot Mailing Dates

Military / out-of-country ballots mailed (45 days prior to election)	Dec. 11	January 23	April 3	August 7	Sept. 18
Out-of-state ballots mailed (29 days prior)	Dec. 28	February 8	April 19	August 23	October 4
In-state, local ballots mailed (18 days prior)	Jan. 8	February 19	April 30	Sept. 3	October 15

* County & City Elections filing officers: Publish notice of receipt of ballot title and notice of measure election as required by charter, ordinance and/or statute, in next available edition of newspaper in electoral district. Note: When a city files a referral with County Elections, the ballot title challenge process must be complete.

** For re-submitted measures the deadline is Sept. 16, the measure argument filing deadline is Sept. 20, if the county includes the re-submitted measure in the voters' pamphlet.
