The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality has completed its review of the revised Site Closure Report concerning the removal action completed for the Fisher Estate property. The property is located at 27863 South Skinner Road, in Estacada, Oregon. The investigation and cleanup work was completed under DEQ oversight pursuant to the terms of a Voluntary Letter Agreement signed by Clackamas County on September 10, 2008. DEQ's Staff Report, dated May 19, 2010, summarizes our review and findings for the Fisher Estate site. The report can be viewed on our web site by searching under the ECSI number, #2731, at:

Pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute, ORS 465.320, and Oregon Administrative Rules, OAR 340-122-100, DEQ invited the public to comment on the proposed "No Further Action" cleanup decision for the site. DEQ published the proposed No Further Action decision in the Estacada News and the Oregon Secretary of State's Bulletin on or about June 1, 2010 and requested public comments through June 30, 2010. No comments were received.

DEQ concludes that the cleanup at the Fisher Estate site is currently protective of public health and the environment and requires no further action under the Oregon Cleanup Law, ORS 465.200 et seq., unless new or previously undisclosed information becomes available. In addition the site will be removed from the Confirmed Release List and the Inventory of Hazardous Substance Sites.
